The Maryhill Café offers a unique place in which to enjoy great food in a fantastic setting. The Café features a variety of light lunches and offers box lunches at discount prices for tour groups. The festive box lunches include your choice of turkey, ham or vegetarian sandwich on a fresh roll, homemade potato salad, drink, fruit and dessert. The cost in 2010 is \$11.50 per person. If 20 or more turkey, ham or vegetarian lunches are ordered, the cost is \$10.50 per person. All prices include sales tax.

Getting to Maryhill

Located in Washington on Scenic Route 14 between Hwy 97 and Hwy 197. It may be reached from Oregon by I-84 via The Dalles Bridge on US 197 (Exit 87) or The Sam Hill Memorial Bridges at Biggs Junction at Hwy 197 (Exit 104). It is a two hour drive east of Portland and four hours southwest of Seattle. Overnight accommodations are available nearby. Parking is free.
